THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to construct RIMROCK SPRINGS WILDLIFE RESERVOIR and store the waters of AN INTERMITTENT STREAM, a tributary of WILLOW CREEK, to be maintained under Application 70369, Permit 51222, for WILDLIFE HABITAT.

This Permit is issued approving Reservoir Application R-70368. The date of priority is MAY 21, 1990. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 20.36 ACRE-FEET.

The dam will be located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 27, T 12 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 3510 FEET SOUTH AND 4100 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 27.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 9.03 acres and the maximum depth of water will be 8.0 feet.

The area to be submerged by the reservoir is located within:

N 1/2 SW 1/4 SECTION 27 TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.

The outlet gate shall be cycled at least once each year and shall be fully operational. The embankment and spillway shall be kept clear of brush, debris, and burrowing animals.

The dam shall be constructed, operated, and maintained according to the approved plans and specifications dated December 6, 1990 on file with the Water Resources Department.

No water shall be stored until this department receives written certification from the engineer that construction has been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, and written authorization for storage is received from this department.

The structure shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered engineer licensed in Oregon.

No fill shall be placed until excavation of the cutoff trench has been completed in its entirety and approved by the engineer.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provisions of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 24, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.
