PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A RESERVOIR AND TO STORE FOR BENEFICIAL USE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to construct ROHLFING RESERVOIR and store the waters of AN UNNAMED INTERMITTENT STREAM, a tributary of ASH SWALE for RECREATION AND WETLAND ENHANCEMENT.

This Permit is issued approving Reservoir Application R-70553. The date of priority is AUGUST 16, 1990. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 30.0 ACRE-FEET.

The dam will be located as follows:

S 1/2 SW 1/4, SECTION 1, T 7 S, R 5 W, W.M.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 15.3 acres and the maximum depth of water will be 6.0 feet.

The area to be submerged by the reservoir is located within:

S 1/2 SW 1/4 SECTION 1 TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

Use under this permit is limited to the reservoir area. This permit does not provide for the appropriation of water for maintaining the water level or maintaining a suitable fresh water condition.

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to regulate waters of the stream system, storage of water in the reservoir shall be subject to the installation of suitable devices for measuring all incoming natural flows and outflows from the reservoir or passing all incoming natural flows. The types and plans for such devices shall be approved by the Watermaster and shall be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The outlet gate shall be cycled at least once each year and shall be fully operational. The embankment and spillway shall be kept clear of brush, debris, and burrowing animals.

The dam shall be constructed, operated, and maintained according to the approved plans and specifications dated November 28, 1990, on file with the Water Resources Department.

No water shall be stored until this department receives written certification from the engineer that construction has been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, and written authorization for storage is received from this department.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 3, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

The permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
