PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A RESERVOIR AND TO
STORE FOR BENEFICIAL USE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO:

to construct AN UNNAMED RESERVOIR and to store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of LITTLE LUCKIAMUTE RIVER, to be maintained under Application 71383, Permit 51313, for RECREATION, FISH AND WILDLIFE HABITAT ENHANCEMENT.

This permit is issued approving Reservoir Application R-71382. The date of priority is MARCH 20, 1991 FOR 11.4 ACRE-FEET (AF) AND JUNE 20, 1991 FOR 7.2 AF. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 18.6 AF.

The dam will be located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 12, T 9 S, R 6 W. W.M.; 1326 FEET SOUTH AND 2553 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, DLC 39.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 2.4 acres and the maximum depth of water will be 15.5 feet.

The area to be submerged by the reservoir is located within:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 12
TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The outlet gate shall be cycled at least once each year and shall be fully operational. The embankment and spillway shall be kept clear of brush, debris, and burrowing animals.

The dam shall be constructed, operated, and maintained according to the approved plans and specifications dated June 21, 1991 on file with the Water Resources Department.

No water shall be stored until this department receives written certification from the engineer that construction has been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, and written authorization for storage is received from this department.

The structure shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered engineer licensed in Oregon.

No fill shall be placed until excavation of the cutoff trench has been completed in its entirety and approved by the engineer.

A new topographical map and area-capacity curve, prepared by an engineer, must be submitted to this department if earth material is removed from the storage area during construction.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 7, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. The reservoir shall be filled and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

The permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
