THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to construct TWO RESERVOIRS and store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of SEVENMILE SLOUGH, to be appropriated under Application 70463, Permit 51380, for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS.

This Permit is issued approving Reservoir Application R-70462. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1990. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 17.2 ACRE-FEET (AF), BEING 8.0 AF IN RESERVOIR 1 AND 9.2 AF IN RESERVOIR 2.

The dams will be located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 3, T 28 S, R 14 W, W.M.

The area submerged by the reservoirs, when full, will be 0.8 acre in Reservoir 1 and 1.15 acres in Reservoir 2. The maximum depth of water will be 10.0 feet in Reservoir 1 and 8.0 feet in Reservoir 2.

The area to be submerged by the reservoirs is located within:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 3 TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to regulate waters of the stream system, use of water shall be subject to the installation of suitable devices for measuring flows diverted into Reservoir No. 1 from, incoming natural flows of basin into reservoir and outflows from the reservoir. The types and plans for such devices shall be approved by the watermaster and shall be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster. Outflow will equal inflow from June 1 to October 31 in Reservoir 1.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife installed, specifications.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provisions of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 9, 1992, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1994.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.
