Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is unnamed stream trib. Skookum Lake
tributary of Willamette River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 40 acre feet.

Tp. 4S, R. 2W, W. M. The maximum height will be 8 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 120 feet; length on bottom 10 feet; width on top 10 feet; slope of front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.
