to construct RESERVOIR A AND RESERVOIR B and store the waters of TWO UNNAMED STREAMS, a tributary of SIXES RIVER, to be appropriated under Application 70918, Permit 51474, for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS.

This Permit is issued approving Reservoir Application R-70917. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 9, 1990. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 3.1 ACRE-FEET (AF), BEING 1.45 AF IN RESERVOIR A, AND 1.65 AF IN RESERVOIR B. The appropriation of water is limited to the period of November through April of each year.

The dam will be located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 31 S, R 15 W, W.M.

The areas submerged by the reservoirs, when full, will be 0.24 ACRE IN RESERVOIR A AND 0.28 ACRE IN RESERVOIR B and the maximum depth of water will be 7.4 feet in each.

The area to be submerged by the reservoirs is located within:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 SECTION 33 TOWNSHIP 31 SOUTH, RANGE 15 WEST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, with a minimum diameter of 8 inches.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 5, 1993, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1996.
