PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A RESERVOIR AND TO
STORE FOR BENEFICIAL USE THE PUBLIC WATERS

THIS PERMIT IS HEREBY ISSUED TO

to construct BRYANT RESERVOIR and store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, to be maintained by appropriation under Application 70370, Permit 51501, for WILDLIFE.

This Permit to store waters is issued approving Reservoir Application R-70198. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 13, 1990. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 27.72 ACRE-FEET.

The dam will be located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 5, T 4 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 2985 FEET NORTH AND 90 FEET WEST FROM S 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 5.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 6.5 acres and the maximum depth of water will be 10.0 feet.

The area to be submerged by the reservoir is located within:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
NE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 5
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The construction, operation and maintenance of the reservoir will be subject to the following conditions:

The structure shall be rehabilitated under the supervision of a registered engineer licensed in Oregon.

The dam shall be constructed, operated, and maintained according to the approved plans and specifications dated July 31, 1990 on file with the Water Resources Department.

The outlet gate shall be cycled at least once each year in order to assure smooth operation.

The embankment and spillway shall be kept clear of trees, brush and other debris.

The embankment shall be kept free of burrowing animals.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 4, 1993, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1996.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

The permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, would not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.
