

Reservoir Permit No. 1148

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, T. J. Sipler (Name of Applicant)

of Route 2, Box 44 - Salem (Mailing Address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Sipler Reservoirs #1 & #2

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Chatnicka Creek tributary of Glenn Creek

3. The amount of water to be stored is 1.7 acre-ft 6 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 19 Tp. 7S, R. 3W, W. M., in the county of Polk (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet In Channel - 6" Iron pipe with valves

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Sec. 19, Tp. 7S, R. 3W, W. M. The maximum height will be 9 1/2 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 150 feet; length on bottom 10 feet; width on top 8 feet; slope of front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 1 feet.

* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: earth dams

No protection from wave action is necessary.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: (State whether over or around the dam)

Around South end of both dams
2' x 2'

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

6" Iron pipe through dams

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1 1/2 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 7 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 4 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$2000.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before February 1951

13. Construction work will be completed on or before two years from approval
