Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, WESTERN AMERICAN LUMBER CO. (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation March 17, 1950; State of Oregon (Principal office - Portland, Oregon)

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Unnamed.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Count Creek

tributary of Siuslaw River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 0153 Acre Feet. acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Fire protection for Mill (Saw) (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 30 (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 30 (Smallest legal subdivision)

surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 16 feet; length on

bottom 20 feet; width on top 7 1/2 feet; slope of front

or water side vertical; slope on back vertical; height of dam above water line

when full 4 feet.
