

Reservoir Permit No. 1184

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

Victor E. Gardener, I, Gardener (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Gardener Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Yankee Creek

tributary of Antelope

3. The amount of water to be stored is 925 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 20 Tp. 36 S., R. 1 E., W. M., in the county of Jackson (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Situated in channel of running stream.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 20, Tp. 30 S., R. 1 E., W. M. The maximum height will be 15 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 1100 feet; length on bottom 200 feet; width on top 20 feet; slope of front or water side 3 to 1; slope on back 2 to 1; height of dam above water line when full 5 feet.

* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

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7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: free soil - loam

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8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: around dam - 300 feet

in distance.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: Through dam at 20 ft. elevation - 16" steel pipe cast in concrete.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 53.8 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 50 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 30 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 50,000.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before February, 1950

13. Construction work will be completed on or before February, 1950
