PURPOSE OR USE OF THE STORED WATER: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION TO BE APPROPRIATED UNDER APPLICATION S-74826, PERMIT 52938, AND APPLICATION S-74828, PERMIT 52939

VOLUME OF ALLOWED USE: 110.5 ACRE-FEET EACH YEAR, BEING 76.75 ACRE-FEET IN RESERVOIR #2 AND 33.75 ACRE-FEET IN RESERVOIR #3

THE PERIOD OF ALLOWED USE: WATER MAY BE APPROPRIATED FOR STORAGE FROM NOVEMBER 1 THROUGH JUNE 30 EACH YEAR

DATE OF PRIORITY: OCTOBER 31, 1994

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 8.0 acres for Reservoir #2 and 4.0 acres for Reservoir #3, the maximum depth of water will be 12.8 feet for Reservoir #2 and 9.37 feet for Reservoir #3. The maximum height of the dam shall not exceed 10.0 on either dam.

DAM LOCATION: NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 16, T 9 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 120 FEET SOUTH AND 420 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 16

THE AREA TO BE SUBMERGED BY THE RESERVOIR IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 16

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a

complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.

B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

If the riparian area is disturbed in the process of developing a point of diversion, the permittee shall be responsible for restoration and enhancement of such riparian area to the satisfaction of the Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife.

The use may be restricted if the quality of the source stream, namely the Willamette River, decreases to the point that it no longer meets state and federal water quality standards due to reduced flows.

The permittee shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion. The permittee shall also install a fishway at the obstruction that will provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish. The required screens and fishways are to be in place, functional, and approved by Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife before diversion of any water.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.
