SOURCE OF WATER: AN UNNAMED STREAM, A TRIBUTARY OF MILL CREEK, WITHIN THE WILLAMETTE BASIN

STORAGE FACILITY: ONE UNNAMED RESERVOIR

PURPOSE OR USE OF THE STORED WATER: FIRE PROTECTION, FISH LIFE AND RECREATION

AMOUNT/VOLUME ALLOWED: 78.0 ACRE-FEET EACH YEAR

PERIOD OF ALLOWED USE: WATER MAYBE APPROPRIATED FOR STORAGE DURING THE PERIOD NOVEMBER 1 THROUGH APRIL 30

DATE OF PRIORITY: JULY 14, 1993

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 78.0 acres and the maximum depth of water will be 20.0 feet. The maximum height of the dam shall not exceed 30.0 feet.

DAM LOCATION: SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 22, T4S, R1W, W.M.

THE AREA TO BE SUBMERGED BY THE RESERVOIR IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 22 TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The outlet gate shall be cycled at least once each year and shall be fully operational at all times.

The embankment and lagoon shall be maintained according to the approved asbuilt drawings on file with the Oregon Water Resources Department, stamped and dated on May 13, 1994. Routine maintenance of the embankment and spillway shall be performed as determined necessary to remove trees, brush, debris, and burrowing animals, or to repair areas of erosion and acts of vandalism.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of a fully functional conduit/gate assembly having a minimum diameter of 8 inches.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.
