

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, James D. Trammell (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Trammell Storage

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Knutzen Gulch.

3. The amount of water to be stored is 9.0 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 32 (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

6. The dam will be located in (Smallest legal subdivision), Sec. 25

Tp. 35 S., R. 1 E., W. M. The maximum height will be 9.5 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be entire circumference feet; length on bottom same feet; width on top 20 feet; slope of front or water side 3 to 1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); slope on back 2 to 1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: clay soil fill from excavation. No protection from wave action contemplated.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: none. inflow controlled by regulating feed canal. (State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 90 feet of 10 inch concrete tile, with cement collars. (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1. acres, with a maximum depth of water of 9 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 9.5 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$1300.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before 1 year from date of priority.

13. Construction work will be completed on or before 2 years from date of priority.
