Tp. 27 S., R. 6 W.M. The maximum height will be feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be feet; length on bottom feet; width on top feet; slope of front

or water side feet horizontal to 1 vertical; slope on back feet horizontal to 1 vertical; height of dam above water line

when full feet.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 2 1/4 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 6.5 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 5.2 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 6,000.00.

12. Construction work will begin on or before 1st of June.

13. Construction work will be completed on or before Completed.


