

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

W. B. Walker & Don Van Doren, Applicants, Polk County, Oregon

I, the undersigned, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation. Joint Venture - see attached certificate.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is unnamed. 2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Salt Creek.

tributary of Salt Yamhill River.

3. The amount of water to be stored is 70 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation.

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 13, Tp. 6 S., R. 5 W., W. M. in the county of Polk.

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet. In channel of Salt Creek. Material at outlet will be coarse sand and gravel.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions.

6. The dam will be located in Sec. 14, Tp. 6 S., R. 5 W., W. M. The maximum height will be 15 1/2 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam.

The length on top will be 270 feet; length on bottom 200 feet; width on top 12 feet; slope of front 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line 3 feet.

A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from

waves are as follows: **Concrete** flume and spillway to carry winter flows. Permanent spillway provided for flood flows.

8. The location of easement, with dimensions are as follows: An 11-foot wide channel

to each bank will take most winter flows with a 70-foot emergency spillway provided as shown on the plans.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions

are as follows: Concrete flume as shown on the plans.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be

with a maximum depth of water of 13 feet, and approximate mean depth of water 7 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 6,000.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before One year after approval

13. Construction work will be completed on or before Two years
