The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: RUNOFF, TRIBUTARY TO NETTER CREEK

STORAGE FACILITY: BARLOW NORTH RESERVOIR

PURPOSE OR USE OF THE STORED WATER: TO BE APPROPRIATED UNDER

APPLICATION S-86276, PERMIT 54224, FOR NURSERY USE

MAXIMUM VOLUME: 9.0 ACRE FEET EACH YEAR

PERIOD OF USE: NOVEMBER 1 THROUGH JUNE 30

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 26, 2005.

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 2.5 ACRES. The maximum height of the dam shall not exceed 12.0 FEET.

DAM LOCATION: NE 1/2 NW 1/2, SECTION 19, T4S, R1E, W.M.; 650 FEET SOUTH & 1450 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 19

THE AREA TO BE SUBMERGED BY THE RESERVOIR IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

NE 1/2 NW 1/4
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

A. The Director may require the water user to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the water user to install a meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device within the period stated in the notice. Such installation period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation

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period. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.

B. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

## STANDARD CONDITIONS

Use under this permit is limited to the reservoir area. This permit does not provide for the appropriation of water for maintaining the water level or maintaining a suitable fresh water condition.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of a fully functional conduit/gate assembly having a minimum diameter of 8 inches.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

Construction shall be completed, the reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2010. If the water is not completely applied before this date, and the water user wishes to continue development under the permit, the water user must submit an application for extension of time, which may be approved based upon the merit of the application.

Within one year after complete application of water to the proposed use, the water user shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner (CWRE).
