

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation 1945
PARTIAL OREGON

The name of the proposed reservoir is SANDY FARMS RESERVOIR NO. 1

The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is UNDEVELOPED SPRING & STREAM tributary of TUALATI

The amount of water to be stored is 3/4 acre feet.

The use to be made of the impounded water is IRRIGATION

The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 21 T. 5 N., R. 4 E., W. 3 M., in the county of CLATSOP

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Dam is in channel of stream (dry in summer) material at outlet is clay & gravel

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

The dam will be located in NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 Sec. 21

The maximum height will be 9 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 125 feet; length on bottom 65 feet; width on top 10 feet; slope of front or water side 4-1; slope on back 7-1; height of dam above water line when full 12 feet.

A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from

work are as follows: 1/2" REINFORCED CONCRETE  
and will be used for protection

8. The location of emergency spillway with dimensions are as follows: 5 FEET WIDE x 2  
FEET DEEP HAND ON EAST SIDE OF DAM

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions

are as follows: 5 FEET WIDE x 2 FEET DEEP  
EAST SIDE OF DAM - 30" SIPHON OVER THE  
TOP OF DAM (SEE PLAN)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 10 acres,  
with a maximum depth of water of 7 feet; and approximate mean depth of water

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$500.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before OCTOBER 10, 1952

13. Construction work will be completed on or before EMIL 1954
