

**Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to
Store the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon**

I, CON TAYLOR (Name of Applicant)

State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is WHITE ROCK - IMP. RESERVOIR
NO. 1-A-3074

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Unappropriated Waters of the State

tributary of Willamette River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 1000 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation, power, municipal supply, etc.

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 27 T. 27 N. R. 20 W. M., in the county of LaTone

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in Sec. 27 (smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 27 R. 20 W. M. The maximum height will be 44.4 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 300 feet; length on bottom 300 feet; width on top 16 feet; slope of front or water side 2.1 (feet horizontal to 1 vertical); slope on back 2.1 (feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 44.4 feet.

A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955
