Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Wilson A. Ettinger and Corrine V. Ettinger

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Ettinger Pond

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is and Unnamed Creek

tributary of Thalatin River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 56 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 15, and 16
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)

Reservoir is situated in channel of running stream and the character of the material is clay.

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 Sec. 15
(Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 1S, R. 2W, W. M. The maximum height will be 18 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 235 feet; length on bottom 30 feet; width on top 12 feet; slope of front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 3 feet.
(Foot horizontal to 1 vertical)

* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

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7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: The dam will be of earth fill construction. The dam is located in a sheltered place and damage from wave action is unlikely.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Concrete spillway around the end of the dam; 48 feet long, 10 feet wide and 6 feet deep.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 12" tar dipped corrugated pipe through the dam with headwall and cutoff walls as shown on accompanying plans.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 7.75 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 14.5 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 7 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 3000.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before August 15, 1953

13. Construction work will be completed on or before October 1, 1953
