

Reservoir Permit No. 1572

### Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Sandy Farms (Name of Applicant)

of RT 3 Box 173 (Mailing Address) Boring,

State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation 1925  
Portland, Oregon

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Sandy Farms  
RESERVOIR No. 3 + No 2

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is  
Unnamed Spring Stream  
tributary of TACHE CREEK

3. The amount of water to be stored is #31 #2-6 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation  
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 21

6. The dam will be located in #2 SE 4/4 OF THE NE 1/4 21  
#3 NE 1/4 OF THE NE 1/4 Sec. 21  
(Smallest legal subdivision)  
Tp. 2 S R. 4 E W. M. The maximum height will be 9 feet above stream bed or ground  
surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be #21 25 feet; length on  
bottom #2 50 feet; width on top #21 6 feet; slope of front  
or water side #3 1; slope on back #2 1; height of dam above water line  
when full 2 feet.

12. Construction work will begin on or before October 15, 1954

13. Construction work will be completed on or before Fall 1956
