

• Reservoir Permit No. 1718

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, CITY OF COOS BAY (Name of Applicant) of P. O. Box - COOS BAY, OREGON (Mailing Address)

State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation City of Marshfield (Now Coos Bay) October 24, 1874

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Mingus Park Lake

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Mingus Park Creek

3. The amount of water to be stored is 12.4 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is recreation for City of Coos Bay (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 27 (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

Tp. 25, R. 13, W. M., in the county of Coos

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Located in Chanrel of Mingus Park Creek Earth fill dam at outlet

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 - SE 1/4, Sec. 27 (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 25, R. 13, W. M. The maximum height will be 5 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 200 feet; length on bottom 100 feet; width on top see Map feet; slope of front or water side 1 to 1; slope on back none; height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.

* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: EARTH FILL DAM - CLAY LOAM - ROCK MASONRY 5 FEET HIGH RUNS ALONG 200 FEET OF FACE OF DAM

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: 3'x3' Concrete Outlet (State whether over or around the dam) box with screen opening which is connected by 3x3 concrete box sewer to City Storm Sewer

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: See No. 8 above (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 3.1 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 5 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 4 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 77A Project

12. Construction work will begin on or before Work done in 1938

13. Construction work will be completed on or before completed in 1938
