Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Mt. Baldy Lumber Company, Inc. (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation 4/2/54 Salem

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is The reservoir is to be used as a sawmill log pond.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Yoncalla Creek tributary of Elk Creek

3. The amount of water to be stored is 54 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Sawmill log pond (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 28 (Give sections or townships to be submerged) Tp. 22S, R. 5, W. M., in the county of Douglas

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet No

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions Pond to be filled by a 225 gpm pump through 4-inch steel discharge pipe. (See accompanying sketch)

reservoir 6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 28 (Smallest legal subdivision) Tp. 22S, R. 5, W. M. The maximum height will be 7 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be See Drwg. C 645-1 feet; length on bottom See Drawing C 645-1 feet; width on top 10' - 0" feet; slope of front or water side 2:1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); slope on back 2:1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.

\* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

The construction of ~~dam~~ <sup>dike</sup>, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: The dike to be earth fill construction compacted by earth moving equipment. No wave protection necessary.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: None
