

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Vivian M. Reinhardt (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Reinhardt Reservoir.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Panther Creek and Seepage. tributary of Applegate River.

3. The amount of water to be stored is 2.5 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation. (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 24. (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

Tp. 36 S., R. 2 E., W. M., in the county of Josephine.

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Not in channel. Clay and adobe at outlet.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions 4" pipe from Panther Creek and from seepage.

6. The dam will be located in SW 1/4 Sec. 24. (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 36 S., R. 2 E., W. M. The maximum height will be 7 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 300 feet; length on bottom 200 feet; width on top 12 feet; slope of front or water side 3-1; slope on back 1-2; height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.

\* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be obtained without charge together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: adobe and clay material. 2 foot freeboard.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: wasteway around dam.  
(State whether over or around the dam)  
through hardpan. 4 ft. bottom width, 12 foot top, 2 ft. deep.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: No stream channel.  
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time.)

10. The area submerged by the proposed resevoir, when full, will be 9.22 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 9 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 7 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 2000.00.

12. Construction work will begin on or before Dec. 30, 1956.

13. Construction work will be completed on or before Dec. 30, 1957.
