Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

Remarks: This was started to provide a pumping station for water right
 appl. 28351 Permit 2251 and it is now desired to change it to provide
 more storage of late spring run-off. The 24 inch pipe under the dam provides
 approximately twice the normal winter flow of the creek. In winter
 months the pipe will be unobstructed to provide for this normal flow.
 In periods of heavy storm the pond may fill and water run over the spill way.
 In the spring the pipe will be plugged or a gate (if later installed) will
 hold the run-off impounded for the summer irrigation by siphons.
