Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Nelson's pond

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Croisan Creek
tributary of Willamette River

3. The amount of water to be stored is three acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation & fish propagation
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 2

6. The dam will be located in Lot 11, Sunnyside Fruit Farms #1, Sec. 3
(Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 3, R. 3 W, W. M. The maximum height will be 9 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 100 feet; length on bottom 102 feet; width on top 12 feet; slope of front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.
