9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 6" Steel Pipe Under Dike

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1 1/2 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 9 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 4 1/2 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 2000.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before upon receipt of permit

13. Construction work will be completed on or before OCT. 1, 1958
