Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Campbell reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Deming Creek and Long Creek

tributary of Sprague River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 850 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation
(irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 28 E 1/2
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)

Tp. 36 S., R. 15 E., W. M., in the county of Klamath

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions 4' deep 10' bottom width 3:1 side slopes from Deming Creek and a similar canal from Long Creek.

6. The dam will be located in W 1/2 NE 1/4 and NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 29
(Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 36 S., R. 15 E., W. M. The maximum height will be 30 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 2750 feet; length on bottom 300 feet; width on top 14 feet; slope of front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 4 feet.
(Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: earth fill constructed with carryall in lifts not exceeding 6"

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8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: around North end
(State whether over or around the dam)

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9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 24" steel pipe through base of dam

(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time.)

10. The area submerged by the proposed resevoir, when full, will be 211 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 26 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 11.6 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 9000
