

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Glenn F. Koennecke (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is mill pond

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is McKay Creek

tributary of Dairy Creek

3. The amount of water to be stored is 40 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Mill pond - for log storage
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. SE 1/4 & NW 1/4 of NW 1/4, 7.
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of NW 1/4, Sec. 7,
(Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 1N, R. 2W, W. M. The maximum height will be 10 feet above stream bed or ground

surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 1000 feet; length on

bottom 1000 feet; width on top 15 feet; slope of front

or water side 1; slope on back 1; height of dam above water line
(Feet horizontal to 1 vertical) (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

when full 4 feet.
