

Reservoir Permit No. 1921

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Ivan M. and Doris Gainer (Name of Applicant)

of Route 2, Box 229, Albany (Mailing Address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Gainer Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Murder Creek

tributary of Willamette River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 0.33 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 33 (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

Tp. 10 S., R. 3 W., W. M., in the county of Linn

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet In channel. Portable wood dam

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in NE 1/4 of NE 1/4, Sec. 33 (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 10 S., R. 3 W., W. M. The maximum height will be 3 1/2 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 16 feet; length on bottom 16 feet; width on top 1 feet; slope of front or water side 3 to 1; slope on back 1; height of dam above water line when full 1 feet.

* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Portable wood dam constructed so that it can be removed during winter.
Made out of logs, square timbers, planks and boating veneer.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Wasteway in center of dam.
(State whether over or around the dam)
One foot wide and 6 inches deep. Ditch also cut around west end.
Ditch is 2 feet wide and 10 inches deep.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: Leakage under and around dam passes a lock water.
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time.)
A 3 inch steel pipe will run under center of dam. Pipe will have
two cut-off collars and will have a gate at inlet.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be .05 acres,
with a maximum depth of water of 6 feet; and approximate mean depth of water
6 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 500.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before Started

13. Construction work will be completed on or before October 1, 1958
