

Reservoir Permit No. 1979

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Albert W. Dery (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Dery Pond No. 2

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Unnamed Stream tributary of Coast fork of Willacette River.

3. The amount of water to be stored is 1 acre foot

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation.

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 16 Tp. 18.S., R. 2.W., W.M., in the county of Lane.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 0.3 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 1 1/2 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 3 1/2 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 500.0

12. Construction work will begin on or before Began July 1951

13. Construction work will be completed on or before October 19; 1951
