

Reservoir Permit No. 1984

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Edward G. & Dorothy Porter (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Un-named branch of South Dairy Creek

3. The amount of water to be stored is 3.7 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 32 Tp. 1N., R. 3W., W. M., in the county of Washington (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Sump is off channel Has 6 in. tile inlet & 6 in. tile outlet

Heavy clay material will be excavated from sump

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions Sump to be filled through 6 in. tile inlet

6. The dam will be located in N.E. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4, Sec. 32 (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 1N., R. 3W., W. M. The maximum depth will be 11.5 feet below ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 197 feet; length on bottom 187 feet; width on top 24 feet; slope of front or water side ; slope on back ; height of dam above water line when full 2.0 feet.

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7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows:

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: (State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions are as follows: 6in. tile (All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time.)

10. The area submerged by the proposed resevoir, when full, will be 0.12 acres. with a maximum depth of water of 11.5 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 2.0 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 2000

12. Construction work will begin on or before spring 1957

13. Construction work will be completed on or before summer 1957
