* Reservoir Permit No. 1994

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, John Herincks (Name of Applicant)

of Rt. #1, Box 33, Carnelius, Washington County, (Mailing Address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Herincks Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is an unnamed intermittent stream with a flow of water from the tributary of Carnelius River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 11.5 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 12 Twp. 2 R. 3 W. M., in the county of Washington (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions of canal and dam

6. The dam will be located in Sec. 12 (Smallest legal subdivision) Twp. 2 R. 3 W. M. The maximum height will be 42.2 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 222 feet; length on bottom 272 feet; width on top 11.5 feet; slope of front or water side 3:1; slope on back 4:1; height of dam above water line when full 7.0 feet.

* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

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7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Compacted earth fill using clay from the reservoir side with a minimum of 2 feet freeboard.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: 100' x 0.475' (State whether over or around the dam) at the last end of the dam.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 18" C.S.F. through the bottom of the dam with a variable elevation structure with a variable elevation structure with a flow section 4 feet wide. This structure is designed for a positive control of the water elevation in the reservoir. (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 4.47 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 2.2 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 4 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 500.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before June 1957

13. Construction work will be completed on or before June 1958

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of Herinckx Storage Pond and the storage of water from an unnamed stream and Selby Creek to be appropriated under Application No. 31261, Permit No. 24722 for irrigation, and the dam shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered professional engineer.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 11.5 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is January 2, 1957.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 25, 1958

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1958
