

Reservoir Permit No. 1995

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Nathan D. Wright (Name of Applicant) of Rt 1 Box 424 West Linn (Mailing Address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

3. The amount of water to be stored is 3 acre feet.

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 34 Tp. 25, R. 1E, W. M., in the county of Clackamas (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

6. The dam will be located in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Sec. 34 Tp. 25, R. 1E, W. M. The maximum height will be 9.5 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 100 feet; length on bottom 60 feet; width on top 8 feet; slope of front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: *Earth fill - no wave protection necessary*

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: *Around south end - concrete - 6' wide 2' deep.*

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: *6" steel through center valve control.*
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time.)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be *1* acres, with a maximum depth of water of *7.5* feet; and approximate mean depth of water *3* feet.
