

Reservoir Permit No. 2012

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Ellwyn Brown (Name of Applicant) of Route 1, Box 219, Eugene (Mailing Address) State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation --

3. The amount of water to be stored is 4.5 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 7 (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

6. The Sump dam will be located in NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4, Sec. 7 (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 17 S, R. 4 W, W. M. The maximum height will be feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be feet; length on bottom feet; width on top feet; slope of front or water side ; slope on back ; height of dam above water line when full feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: *Excavated Sump.*

10. The area submerged by the proposed resevoir, when full, will be .25 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 25 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 18 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$6,000.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before May 1957

13. Construction work will be completed on or before June 1957
