This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of Rickini Mill Pond and storage of water from the Coast Fork Willamette River to be appropriated under Application No. 29828, Permit No. 25135, for mill pond, and the dam shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered professional engineer.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 174.0 acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is March 23, 1955.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 29, 1955 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1959.
