

Reservoir Permit No. 2103

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Sec. 22 (Smallest legal subdivision)

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: *4 FT. Cedar Log across stream with earth fill on upstream side to prevent water from going under it*

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: *Notch 6" deep by 3' wide in upper surface of Log.*
(State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: *4" steel pipe under Log.*
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time.)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be *13* acres, with a maximum depth of water of *2'2* feet; and approximate mean depth of water *1'* feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ *500⁰⁰*

12. Construction work will begin on or before *April 1st 1958*

13. Construction work will be completed on or before *June 1958*
