

Reservoir Permit No. 2116

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

3. The amount of water to be stored is 6,000,000 acre feet.

6. The dam will be located in SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4, Sec. 28 (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 4 S., R. 3 W., W. M. The maximum height will be 6.7 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 100 feet; length on bottom 200 feet; width on top 10 feet; slope of front or water side 1:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 1 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Earth fill

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 250

12. Construction work will begin on or before April 28 1958

13. Construction work will be completed on or before May 1958

Remarks: Legal description of property on which the Dam and Reservoir  
are located.

Beginning at a stone in the center of the County Road at the most Westerly Northwest corner of the Gabriel S. Chrisman Donation Land Claim, Notification No. 1018, Claim No. 51, Township 4 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, from which an Oak 8" in diameter marked by J. C. Cooper in C. S. #87 C bears South 52° West 103 links, thence South 0° 29' West along center of County Road 28.60 chains, thence West 13.67 chains to a stake on the East line of B. M. Robinson Donation Land Claim, thence North 0.46 of a chain to a stake from which a fir 16" in diameter bears North 56 1/4° East 11 links, thence West 11.73 chains to stake at the Southeast corner of County Survey #347 (being the Southeast corner of land formerly owned by Joseph Fletcher), thence North 0° 45' West 28.34 chains to old wire fence, thence South 87° 35' East along old wire fence 2.11 chains to corner, thence North 1.15 chains to the North line of the B. M. Robinson Donation Land Claim, thence South 89° East 22.57 chains to the place of beginning, containing 65.30 acres, more or less.
