State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to <sup>already constructed</sup> construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Christensen

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Unnamed Stream  
tributary of McKay Creek - FANNO CREEK

3. The amount of water to be stored is 45 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 3  
(Smallest legal subdivision)  
Tp. 2S, R. 1W, W. M. The maximum height will be 8 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 200 feet; length on bottom 170 feet; width on top \_\_\_\_\_ feet; slope of front or water side 3; slope on back 2; height of dam above water line when full 2 1/2 feet.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1 1/2 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 6 ft. feet; and approximate mean depth of water 3 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ done in 1935

12. Construction work will begin on or before done in 1935

13. Construction work will be completed on or before finished in 1938
