Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, CLYDE L. THOLEN (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Numbers 1, 2, 3 & 4

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is

unnamed stream and spring tributary of Beaver Creek Drainage Area

3. The amount of water to be stored is less than 3,000,000 gal. in eq. acre feet. 4 acre ft being 1 af in each 1,000 gal.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation & stock (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 22 & 23 (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

Tp. 33, R. 2, W. M. The maximum height will be 9 feet above stream bed or ground

surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 100 feet; length on

bottom 50 feet; width on top 9 feet; slope of front

or water side 3 feet; slope on back 2 feet; height of dam above water line (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

when full 4 feet.
