

Reservoir Permit No. 249 CERTIFICATE NO. 966

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A RESERVOIR AND TO STORE FOR BENEFICIAL USE THE UNAPPROPRIATED WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

I, N H Latimer (Name of Applicant) of Seattle, County of King State of Washington do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Knight Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Middle Fork of Foots Creek

3. The amount of water to be stored is 2 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 12 T 37 S R 4 West of W. M. (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions Filled through a feed canal called Knight Ditch 2100 feet long 3 feet wide at top - 2 feet wide at bottom and 2 feet deep.

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 of NE 1/4, Sec. 13 (Smallest legal subdivision)

*A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

Tp. **37 S** R. **4 W**, W. M. It will be **3 1/2** feet in height, having a length on top of **30** feet; length on bottom **25** feet; width on top **6** feet; slope of front or water side **1/2** feet horizontal to 1 vertical; slope on back **same**; height of dam above water line when full **one** feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: **Timber and earth**

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: **Through center of dam 4 feet wide, 3 1/2 feet high.** (State whether over or around the dam)

In case of flood this is opened wide, under normal condition the opening is 1 foot high.

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: **Through the east end of dam. Is made of timber and 24" wide and 12" high** (State whether through or around the proposed dam)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be **13,000 sq. ft. acres**, with a maximum depth of water of **12** feet, and approximate mean depth of water **10** feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ **Already constructed**

12. Construction work will begin on or before **as part of placer mining**

13. Construction work will be completed on or before **Works are owned by applicant**
