

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

1. BUREAU of LAND MANAGEMENT (Name of Applicant) of P.O. Box 392 Eugene (Mailing Address) State of OREGON do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is WHITTAKER CREEK RECREATION DAM Site

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is WHITTAKER CREEK tributary of SIUSLAW RIVER

3. The amount of water to be stored is 1 2/3 acre feet. TEMPORARY STORAGE FOR SUMMER

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is MONTHS FOR RECREATION SITE (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 21 (Give sections or townships to be submerged) Tp. 16S R. 8W, W.M., in the county of LANE

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Bedrock, Normal Channel Storage

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 (Smallest legal subdivision), Sec. 21, Tp. 16S R. 8W, W.M. The maximum height will be 5 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 50 feet; length on bottom 46 feet; width on top 12 feet; slope on front or water side NONE (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); slope on back NONE (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 12 feet.

\* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Flash board with 12' Cement base. Cement wings

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Center of DAM 4" x 8' (State whether over or around the dam)

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: See # 8 Above (All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1/2 acre, with a maximum depth of water of 4 1/2 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 2 1/2 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 1500.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before Aug 30 1961

13. Construction work will be completed on or before Sept 15 1961
