7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: The dam will be constructed of clay loam from both sides of stream + upper end of basin. If protection from waves is necessary will use timber cribbing

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Around East end of dam with a bottom width of 5ft a top width of 6ft + depth of 2'5" from top of dam

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: Outlet to be of 18" concrete pipe encased in concrete in stream bed with gate at upper end

10. The proposed reservoir for the proposed dam will be a pond with a maximum depth of water of 1' 7" and average normal depth of water 5 1/2 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 2500 -
