

Reservoir Permit No. 2702

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Butler Farm

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Overflow from City of Monmouth Reservoir

3. The amount of water to be stored is one acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

6. The dam will be located in sixty feet East of Monmouth, Sec. 25, City Reservoir (Smallest legal subdivision) W.M. The maximum height will be 20 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 100 feet; length on bottom 200 feet; width on top 6 feet; slope on front or water side 3 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); slope on back 3 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.

7. The construction of ^{Reservoir} ~~dam~~, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Earth.

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 2 acres, with a maximum depth of water of six feet and approximate mean depth of water five feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 500.
