Reservoir Permit No. 2705

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Walter M. Cory (Name of Applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation None

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Walt Cory Stock pond

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Tributary to West Fork of Crooked Creek tributary of Chewaucan River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 0.1 acre feet

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Stock water (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 34 in S. 4, T. 1, R. 20 E., W.M., in the county of Lake

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Intermittent stream (In March of 1961 the stream carried water for about a week) Loam soil

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in S. 4, T. 1, R. 20 E., W.M., Sec. 35, Tp. 3 S., R. 20 E., W.M. The maximum height will be 10 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 50 feet; length on bottom 6 feet; width on top 10 feet; slope on front or water side 3.7; slope on back 2.1; height of dam above water line when full 2 feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Earth Fill

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: (State whether over or around the dam)

Top To: Width = 1' Bottom width = 1'

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 6" pipe through dam (see Ltr. 1-15-62) wwp.
(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 3500 sq feet acres, with a maximum depth of water of 3.3 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 1.36 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 3,000

12. Construction work will begin on or before December 1961

13. Construction work will be completed on or before April 1963
