### Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation NONE

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is UNNAMED

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is UNNAMED TRIBUTARY  
tributary of MILL CREEK

3. The amount of water to be stored is 30 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is IRRIGATION  
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 22  
(Give sections or township to be submerged)  
Tp. 45 R. 1W, W.M., in the county of MARION

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet

6. The dam will be located in N 1/4 SW 4 Sec. 22  
(Smallest legal subdivision)  
Tp. 45 R. 1W, W.M. The maximum height will be 9.9 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 100 feet; length on bottom 20 feet; width on top 10 feet; slope on front or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 2.5 feet.  
(Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: EARTH FILL.

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: AROUND

normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 10 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 10.0 feet: and approximate mean depth of water 3.0 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 1200<sup>00</sup>

12. Construction work will begin on or before 9-1-61

13. Construction work will be completed on or before 10-15-61
