State of *Oregon* do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is *Fancy Creek Reservoir*

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is *Unnamed tributary of Pinto Creek which is a minor stream flowing generally southwardly from the base of the Blue Mts. into the Columbia River*, a tributary of

3. The amount of water to be stored is *1,000,000 cubic feet, or 2,366 acre feet*

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is *Irrigation, domestic supply, etc.*

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. *A 1/4 Section and Township*

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet

6. The dam will be located in *N 1/4* Sec. 1/4 Smallest legal subdivision

Tp. *16 S.*, R. *1 E.*, W.M. The maximum height will be *31* feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be *915* feet; length on bottom *160* feet; width on top *1514* feet; slope on front or water side *3-1*; slope on back *2-1*; height of dam above water line when full *3* feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 11,600.

12. Construction work will begin on or before 6/4/97 / 1997

13. Construction work will be completed on or before October 1, 1980.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the construction of Emery Moore Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream to be appropriated under application No. 47298, permit No. 27929, and application No. 5053, permit No. 27920, for irrigation and the dam shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered professional engineer.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 166.4 September 1st, 1961 for 150 a.f. acre feet.

The priority date of this permit is May 14, 1962 for 6.4 a.f.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 26, 1963 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1964.
