

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, The Taylor Ranch Inc., of 37 North J. Street, Lakeview State of Oregon do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation November 1, 1956 Lakeview, Oregon

- 1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Enlargement of White Rock Reservoir
2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is White Rock Creek

tributary of Thomas Creek, a Tributary of Goose Lake

3. The amount of water to be stored is 548.6 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation and supplemental irrigation

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 26 and 27 Tp. 37.S., R. 20.E., W.M., in the county of Lake

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Water collected from surface runoff in wet weather channel and diversions thru ditch from White Rock Creek.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions

6. The dam will be located in SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 27 & SE 1/4 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 26 Tp. 37.S., R. 20.E., W.M. The maximum height will be 2 Dams 15 & 25 feet above stream bed or ground

surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 860 and 1074 feet; length on bottom feet; width on top 12 and 14 feet; slope on front

or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line when full 4 feet.

\* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Earth fill dam with rock riprap

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: around dam (State whether over or around the dam.) 20 ft. wide on bottom

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 10" and 12" pipes as show on respective plans for each dam. (All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 79.4 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 22 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 7.3 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 17,000.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before October 1, 1962

13. Construction work will be completed on or before October 1, 1963

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The right herein granted is limited to the ~~construction~~ ~~enlargement~~ of White Rock Creek Reservoirs and storage of water from White Rock Creek to be appropriated under application No. 34204, permit No. 28099 for irrigation and supplemental irrigation and the dam shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered professional engineer.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the ~~storage of~~ additional storage of 545.9 acre feet in Reservoirs Nos. 1, 2 and 3 and 2.7 acre feet in Reservoir No. 4.

The priority date of this permit is August 5, 1960

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 5, 1963 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1964
