

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of OREGON, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is

3. The amount of water to be stored is 30-3 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Stock Water (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 19 (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

6. The dam will be located in 1/4 NE 1/4, Sec. 19 (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 34S, R. 21E, W.M. The maximum height will be 10 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 150 feet; length on bottom 100 feet; width on top 12 feet; slope on front or water side 3:1; slope on back 1:1; height of dam above water line when full 20 feet.

* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Catawilla & Dam, Cat. Co., Oregon

8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: Across road
(State whether over or around the dam)

at South Side - Top of Dam - 15' wide
Bottom 14' 2" wide
Depth 2' 6" high

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions are as follows:

(All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, of such capacity and location to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time)

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 100 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 6 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 3.5 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 7500

12. Construction work will begin on or before April 15, 1962

13. Construction work will be completed on or before May 1962

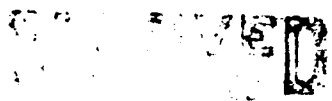
