State of **Oregon**, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

Tp. **4** R. **7** S. **W.M.** The maximum height will be **6** feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be **12** feet; length on bottom **6** feet; width on top **5** feet; slope on front or water side **3:1** Feet horizontal to 1 vertical; slope on back **2:1** Feet horizontal to 1 vertical; height of dam above water line when full **2** feet.
