# Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

State of **OREGON**, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is **Hendricks Reservoir No. 1**

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is **winter run-off**

tributary of **Tygh Creek**

3. The amount of water to be stored is **3.4** acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is **Livestock**  
(Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. **10**  
(Give sections or townships to be submerged)

6. The dam will be located in **NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4**, Sec. **10**  
(Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. **3S**, R. **13E**, W.M. The maximum height will be **10** feet above stream bed or ground

surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be **210** feet; length on

bottom **100** feet; width on top **10** feet; slope on front

or water side **3 : 1**; slope on back **2 : 1**; height of dam above water line  
(Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

when full **2** feet.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Earth fill built with dozer

9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: on South end of fill native earth

10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 1 acre - 0 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 8 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 3.4 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 1040

12. Construction work will begin on or before done in previous years

13. Construction work will be completed on or before already completed
